The Grassland Improvement Program improves the health and diversity of grasslands. This is a partnership with Pheasants Forever, Quail Forever, the Nebraska Environmental Trust, the Nebraska Game & Parks Commission, Natural Resources Conservation Service, and the US Fish & Wildlife Service. Landowners accepted in the program will receive an incentive of \$35-\$60 per acre to defer grazing on enrolled grasslands for one calendar ear when prescribed burning and other grassland improvements are performed on the grasslands the following year.
