Shane completed survival checks for spring 2020 tree planting. Total survival percentage for all trees and shrubs 61%. Shane mentioned that the higher survivals came from those that were mulched.

Water Quantity

Anna reported that 6 applications for expansion of irrigated acres were approved for 2021. Three from Blaine County and three from McPherson County for a total of 593 acres / 81-acre feet depletions. This leaves our NRD well under our allotted first – five-year increment amount.

Water Quality

Sub-district 5 domestic water quality testing has been completed for the year. 91 wells were tested with the average nitrate level being 1.38 mg/L well under the EPA's safety level of 10 mg/L

<u>Current NRD Projects</u> – ERC emo has been rescheduled for Thursday December 3^{rd} . Will begin with a presentation here at the ULNRD Learning Center at 9:00 a.m. CT and then move out to the demo site (east of Halsey) around 10:30 a.m.

Grant Reports

Anna submitted two final reports and reimbursement request for the Firehall Arboretum project. One to the Greener Towns Grant program, for the main project, and one to the Academy of Science for signage.

<u>Coalition/Alliance</u> – LPSB technical group held a meeting. They will be recommending to the manager's group that we start with the same accounting methods as the last increment but use more current data. Once the new models are complete and the proven science is available, we will adjust the accounting methods as needed. As of now it appears as though each District will have some reductions in allotted acre feet depletions for the second-five-year increment.

NARD Report

Judy provided a report to the directors. She announced as of now legislative conference was still going to happen but without the senator's reception. The re-scheduled National Envirothon is still scheduled but in the air if it will be in person or virtual
