Activities



Soils and Land - Play in the dirt! Campers will learn about the basic components of soil and how it functions. They will also learn to read the landscape by examining its topography and make deductions about its history and use. Finally, they will make "mud balls" as a means to restore native plants on pasture land.



Career Education — Careers in natural resources conservation

tion, management, research and technology will be introduced to campers through an interactive presentation provided by a representative of the University of Nebraska-Lincoln.



Water Quality - Clear water is not necessarily clean water. Campers will learn hands-on how to determine water quality and test for safe drinking water. Activities will include water quality sampling, testing, and analysis.

Wildlife - Aquatics - Do you enjoy learning about Wildlife? Investigate wildlife habitats, hides, skulls, scat, teeth, and other bones. Explore a stream and identify aquatic creatures and how they help determine the health of a stream. Learn how humans impact wildlife survival.

Dates & Location: June 5th-June 8th, 2011, State 4-H Camp, Halsey, Nebraska.

Arrival/Departure: Arrive at 4:00PM CST Sunday, June 5, 2011. Camp ends at 3:00PM on Wednesday, June 8. Transportation to and from camp will be the parents' responsibility. Please arrive promptly with your campers but not before 4:00PM. The Camp is for 6th-8th graders. They must have **completed** 6th, 7th or 8th grade in the **2010-2011 year**.

Camp Cost: \$180. The fee and registration form are due by Friday, May 6th, 2011. Once the registration form has been received additional information will be sent back to registered campers. **\$25.00 of that fee will be non-fundable.**

Activities

Range and Grassland - Long known as "Cattle Country" in the heart of Nebraska, campers will explore the grasslands of the Sandhills and get up close and personal with many range plant species with the help of a Range Scientist.

"What tree is that?" They will also create a tree planting plan and experience a tree planter implement first hand.
